Greg Norris Memorial Health Scholarship awarded

At a special morning tea ceremony with Mayor Sally Doyle on Wednesday 8 November 2023, local resident Annie Redgrove was presented with this year's Greg Norris Memorial Health Scholarship.

Through the Greg Norris Memorial Health Scholarship, Annie has been awarded \$5,000 to help progress her studies towards a Masters in Psychology.

Ms Redgrove plans to be a provisionally registered psychologist by the end of 2026.

"By the time I am registered, I will have studied for eight years. This is a long project that I have put a lot of time and work into, and I am determined to get to the end," Ms Redgrove told Mayor Doyle.

"As a resident of the Huon Valley, I look forward to eventually practicing psychology and offering counselling as an allied health professional in this municipality."

"The Huon Valley Council is delighted to support Annie as she embarks on this next stage of her studies in health and medicine. We wish her all the best and look forward to the positive contribution she will make to our valley," said Mayor Doyle.

Applications for the 2024 Greg Norris Memorial Scholarship will be advertised in December.

Anyone wishing to apply needs to show that they reside in the Huon Valley Local Government area at the time of application and would find it difficult to access further education without receiving scholarship support. Preference is given to applicants whose study may lead to a future career in rural healthcare.
