Community Vision for the Huon Valley

A comprehensive community engagement process is about to get underway to develop the Huon Valley Community Vision that will help plan the future for the valley.

Mayor Sally Doyle said council is eager to capture the hopes, aspirations, values, and priorities from as many residents as possible.

"The involvement from the community is critical because the community vision provides a guide for the future growth and development of the Huon Valley region. It enables future directions and priorities to be drawn that are meaningful and purposeful.

"The vision provides overarching guidance and links through to a hierarchy of other council strategic plans and strategies," Mayor Doyle said.

"We will be seeking to find out what is important to the community and what it is they value."

The first engagement activity will be conducted at the Huon Show on Saturday 12 November.

"The Huon Show attracts a lot of local residents so it's the perfect setting to introduce the project and encourage people to get involved," Mayor Doyle said.

"This preliminary engagement will build an initial snapshot of the views and perceptions of the Huon Valley community."



Further engagement activities will be conducted with the broader community between now and February 2023.
